## **UNITY UPDATE**

### Where is our hope?

**Rev Simon Tillotson writes...** 

Dear Friends,

Right the way through the winter months I look forward to the arrival of British Summer Time. In my memory is etched, through those dark, cold winter days, memories of late spring evenings with the sunlight and smell of fresh spring flowers coming through the window.



This April, though, is so far turning out to be rather different. It reminds me of the April I spent in 2013 on my sabbatical studying here at the Vicarage with the heating on nearly as often as it had been in the winter months, peering out at rain filled clouds...

This has all come as a stark reminder that the hope we often place in our worldly expectations does not always find fulfilment. Of course, sometimes, God does bless us with something significant to give thanks for. Other times, we are left feeling let down and disappointed. However, knowing that reality can actually be quite important for the welfare of our mental health, because if we expect things to always go well we will live in a frequent state of disappointment. Something of our consumer culture creates those idealistic expectations. We need to be aware of them, and can actually be happier if we are aware of them. That's not to say we shouldn't hope for a great amount of happiness in this life. Of course we should! But mindful realism is also important. Making an idol out of our expectations is dangerous.

The month of May sees the arrival of Pentecost, amongst other festivals. This gives us a great opportunity to review where our primary spiritual and emotional focus is. Is it on God, or is it on the unreliable things of this world? If it is the latter, and not God, we may well never enter into the fulness of life Jesus promises us. The reality of the imperfection of life therefore makes it all the more important to place our hope not in the world around us but in God, in whom all joy and fulfilment can ultimately be found.
