Alms House vacancy in Tankerton, Whitstable

Seasalter Parish Charities is an alms house charity based in the Seasalter and Whitstable area. The Charity currently has a vacancy in our Seasalter House building on Tankerton Road. The flat is a self-contained one-bedroom flat on the second floor (accessed via stairs) suitable for an individual or a couple. We are inviting eligible people/ couples to apply. To be eligible you (you both) will need:

- to be living in the Seasalter and/or Whitstable area and,
- to be 60 years old or older and,
- to have limited means and assets and,
- to be capable of independent living.

Residents pay a monthly maintenance contribution and are responsible for Council Tax and utilities.


